#### Parent Support / Liaison Role:

Most of you will probably already know Mrs Spencer as our wonderful Senior Learning Support Assistant in school. This year however, in addition to her current role, Mrs Spencer will be undertaking a role of parent contact support.. She now has specific time in her week to work with school families with a range of services. This role will involve Mrs Spencer supporting families with attendance, lateness, uniform queries and homework. As part of this role, Mrs Spencer will also be running parent and child workshops and developing community links too.

We are really excited to have Mrs Spencer supporting in this way, and think her role will complement and enhance the work that already goes on within school.

If you wish to contact Mrs Spencer she will be on the yard at home time every Tuesday and Wednesday or alternatively you can message the office or speak to your child's class teacher to get in touch with her.
